In Fall 2026, **every** high school senior will be directly admitted to college in North Carolina.* Your spot is waiting for you.



YOUR MOMENT IS COMING. DON'T LET IT PASS YOU BY! With NC College Connect, you will be directly admitted to participating colleges where you already meet admissions requirements. No essays, test scores, or recommendation letters needed. Yes, it's that easy.

Seniors — if you start your senior year at a North Carolina public high school and are on track to graduate, you're eligible to participate in NC College Connect! Yes, all of you! **You'll receive your NC College Connect letter this fall** with more information about where you've been admitted.

NC College Connect is a program that directly admits North Carolina public high school seniors to participating UNC System universities, North Carolina Independent Colleges and Universities, and their local North Carolina community college where they already meet admissions requirements.

All eligible students will be directly admitted to their local community college. If you ended your junior year with a weighted GPA of 2.8 or higher, have a fourth-level math, and meet program requirements, you'll be automatically admitted into additional 4-year colleges and universities. The higher your GPA, the more schools to which you'll be directly admitted.
