Completing the FAFSA and NC RDS can unlock access to many types of financial aid for eligible students.	FAFSA Federal Student Aid Complete the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) to determine eligibility for federal, state, and college-based financial aid.	RESIDENCY DETERMINATION SERVICE (RDS) Use NC RDS (Residency Determination Service) to receive an RCN (Residency Certification Number) to determine eligibility for in-state tuition and/or state grant awards.

First Step?	Set up a studentaid.gov account— required for students and parents of dependent students.	Log in to NC RDS using your CFNC.org username and password. If you don't have one, you'll be able to set one up from the login page.
When? (recommended)	Set up studentaid.gov account before Oct. 1; Submit the FAFSA as soon as possible after Oct. 1.	Ideally before student applies to NC colleges and universities.

What to Save After Completing Form?	Studentaid.gov account username and password to review the FAFSA Submission Summary (FSS).	RCN to share with NC colleges/ universities for in-state financial aid consideration.
