

#### Residency | FAFSA | Applications

Countdown to College (C2C) supports college access every October. C2C activities help high school seniors complete three important college enrollment steps: residency, FAFSA, and applications. Many NC colleges and universities will support C2C by waiving application fees during College Application Week.

NC Countdown to College will take place during the month of October of 2023 and College Application Week (when many NC colleges have free applications) will be Oct 16-20.

## **ProTools – Overview and Access Instructions**

- Access your <u>ProTools</u> account cfnc.org/protools
- Assist students with login issues prior to College Application Week (CAW)
- Review application process, transcript tracking, do career reporting, and more.


There are two steps in gaining access to ProTools:

- Ensure that you have a CFNC.org account tied to your official school/organization email address. You can either create a new CFNC.org account or edit the email address in an existing account (My Dashboard > My Profile).
- Complete the <u>online request form</u> to add ProTools permissions to your CFNC.org account. Please allow 2 weeks for verification of your school/organization affiliation and processing.



## What is NC Countdown to College?

North Carolina Countdown to College (C2C) is a statewide initiative sponsored by CFNC. It is a month long initiative that encompasses FAFSA, RDS, and applications.



The goal of the C2C initiative is to increase the number of students who pursue postsecondary education by assisting high school seniors with the college admissions process (residency, FAFSA, and applications) and ensuring that each participating student submits at least one admissions application.

## **September Overview**

During September, C2C and CFNC offers an <u>entire month</u> of professional development opportunities, with CEUs offered. These trainings focus on the three main areas of C2C: residency, FAFSA, and admissions, in a variety of

unique ways.

We have two C2C Site Coordinator Trainings planned in August and September, and have moved Education Professionals Training to an entire month this year, offering 8 sessions in September and CEU credits.

## Planning Tasks

- Request funding & prize donations
- Determine CAW structure
- Reserve computer lab, library, classroom space for CAW
- Begin organizing family financial aid nights
- Continue classroom workshops – introduce FAFSA & create FSA ID's

- 2. Get buy-in from school staff
- 3. Solidify C2C outreach

#### Planning Tasks

- Share C2C plans with teachers and staff
- Design outreach materials (fliers, bulletin board, etc.) for C2C – CAW, etc.
- Confirm C2C workshop speakers (ex: CFNC Spanish Services)
- Continue classroom workshops
   college list building, RDS, financial aid awareness, etc.
- Promote and have students collect necessary materials for RDS drive

- Track how many students are completing at least 1 college application
- Continue classroom workshops

- Host RDS drive and supplemental College Application Clinic







## **October Overview and Activities**

## Planning Your Site for NC C2C

- Perform <u>technology preparations</u>
  - Ensure your IT staff reviews the list of whitelisted websites.
  - Work with technology support staff to ensure that firewalls or other access restrictions will not prevent students from accessing online applications the day of the event.
- Coordinate a site team and reach out to volunteers
- Plan your events suggested themes:
  - Week 1: Plan Your Future
  - Week 2: RDS & FAFSA
  - Week 3: College Application Week
  - Week 4: I Applied, What's Next?
- Promote your events



## **October Overview and Activities**

- <u>Virtual student sessions</u> happening throughout the month
  - Spanish services offered during select student sessions
- Virtual Career Fair on October 5, 2023 3:30-5pm
- College Application Week: October 16-20<sup>th</sup> (to 11:59pm on 10/20/23)
  - List of colleges who have opted to waive fees will be released on October 1st.

## **Activity Suggestions**

Remember not to get overwhelmed! Pick 1 or 2 activities to do with students each week during October. For example –

#### **Week One:**

- ✓ Meet with all seniors to ensure they can log into their CFNC accounts & have the correct HS listed.
- ✓ Encourage students to attend our <u>virtual career fair</u>.
- ✓ Consider holding a parent meeting with one of our <u>Spanish Services Reps</u> for DACA students or mixed-status families.

#### **Week Two:**

- ✓ Send information home with all seniors about **RDS** and <u>why</u> it needs to be completed. Also, a simple direction sheet with information on <u>where</u> to access it.
- ✓ Hold a Financial Aid Information session for students & parents in the evening (record & send out for those who could not attend). Encourage them to get their <u>FSA IDs</u>. Consider reaching out to your local college's financial aid office and your <u>CFNC Regional Representative</u>.



## **Activity Suggestions**

#### **Week Three:**

- ✓ College Application Week! Get your whole school involved!
  - ✓ Have teachers wear their alma matter apparel & list what college they attended <u>outside their</u> <u>classroom doors</u>.
  - ✓ Have 1-5 days open for students to complete college applications in a computer lab
  - ✓ Share these <u>Admissions Essay Tips</u> with your students

#### **Week Four:**

- ✓ Encourage students to (virtually) attend sessions this week about next steps
- ✓ Plan events with your <u>CFNC Regional Representatives</u> to present these next steps to students and/or parents in-person.
- ✓ Offer a handout to all seniors on what to expect next
  - ✓ RDS RCNs and reconsiderations
  - ✓ FAFSA Offer letters
  - ✓ College Admissions


